



OPENING OF RECEIVING APPLICATIONS: 2019/2020 ADMISSIONS -

BACHELOR OF MEDICINE AND BACHELOR OF SURGERY (MBBS) PROGRAMME

A. ABOUT DAEYANG UNIVERSITY

Daeyang University is a Christian University founded by the Miracle for Africa Foundation, **registered** and **accredited** by the National Council for Higher Education (NCHE). The campus is located within the complex which also houses Daeyang Luke Hospital, in Kanengo, Lilongwe. It is off the M1 road that passes between Kamuzu International Airport, behind Malawi Institute of Management (MIM). It started with the establishment of Daeyang College of Nursing in 2010 and Daeyang College of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in 2014. Both Colleges offer programme which are **registered** and **accredited** by NCHE. The MBBS programme is a **registered** and **accredited** programme of the University of Malawi, College of Medicine. Daeyang University is offering this programme jointly with the University of Malawi since 2015.

B. THE MBBS PROGRAMME

The University embarked on a Medical School Project in 2015 to assist the Malawi nation in the training of medical doctors. The project involves construction of a medical school campus which will include a teaching hospital. The ground breaking ceremony for the project was held on 12th March 2016, and was presided over by the State President, His Excellency Professor Arthur Peter Mutharika, who is also Champion for Higher Education in Africa. It is planned that the teaching hospital will be operational by the year 2020.

Daeyang University and the College of Medicine of the University of Malawi signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the joint training of students who are admitted under this programme. Students follow the approved University of Malawi MMBS curriculum and are placed at College of Medicine for the foundation year and for the pre-clinical years, utilizing University of Malawi academic and administrative resources, facilities, infrastructure, and human resource capacity. Daeyang University provides the required financial support to the programme.

Daeyang University believes in biblical principles and values and these are reflected in its teaching and training process. Students are therefore required to apply the same in their learning process. Its graduates are expected to demonstrate professionalism and desire to live a God-centered life. Throughout their lives, graduates will have a heart to love all people from all nations, a desire to live imitating Jesus Christ as servant-leaders, and a passion to work for the Kingdom of God.

C. CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSIONS

The University invites applications from interested candidates to enrol for the **Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS)** programme as detailed in the table below, under **Section D**.

D. THE PROGRAMME, ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND DURATION

E. FEES

Tuition fees	:	K450,000 per Semester
Administrative & registration fee	:	K60,000 per Academic Year
Students' Council fee	:	K5,000 per Academic Year
Medical fee	:	K21,600 per calendar year
Accommodation	:	K20,000 per month
Meals	:	K45,000 per month for 3 meals per day.

- **NOTE: For MBBS candidates, further categories of admission may include self-sponsored students who would be required to pay full economic cost for the training which is US \$5,722.58 tuition per academic year for Malawians and SADC nationals; and US \$8,722.50 for Non-Malawians from outside SADC. Candidates wishing to be considered under these categories should clearly state so in their application.**

The fees are subject to revision at any time. The above fees do not include costs for other requirements such as personal lap top computers, uniform during practical placements, protective wear for laboratory sessions and other programme-specific requirements. Candidates should therefore prepare for these additional costs. Detailed will be provided to the successful candidates at a later stage.

F. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications should be sent by post, courier or delivered by hand at Daeyang University. Applications sent by e-mail or by fax will **NOT** be accepted.

Applicants should write an application letter and provide the following information:

- a) name, date of birth and sex;
- b) contact telephone numbers and for the parents/guardians/sponsor(s);
- c) e-mail address(es);
- d) disclose any form of disability;
- e) religious affiliation and statement about motivation or willingness to abide by the Christian values of the University;
- f) name of previous school;
- g) year when the Malawi School Certificate of Education examinations or examinations for the equivalent certificate was obtained;
- h) examination number;
- i) list of subjects written and the grades obtained in each subject;
- j) proof of ability to pay fees by attaching a letter from a parent/guardian/sponsor confirming sponsorship;

- k) attach a certified copy of the academic qualification or notification of results or letter of results signed by the head teacher, bearing a school date stamp;
- l) For MBBS candidates, please indicate if you wish to be considered as self-sponsored to pay economic fees if not selected under the normal admission.

Alternatively, applicants may fill in an application form which can be obtained from the University Campus or downloaded from the website www.dyuni.ac.mw. The application form can also be requested via the following e-mail: registrar@dyuni.ac.mw.

A complete application package with the above information should be sent or delivered with evidence that you have deposited a non-refundable admission application fee of **K15,000**. Applications submitted without attaching a bank deposit slip for the admission application fee will be disqualified.

G. INTERVIEWS

Applicants will be required to undergo oral interviews.

The date for the interviews will be communicated to the shortlisted candidates at a later stage.

Candidates will meet their own costs for transport, meals and accommodation. Candidates shall also be required to bring writing materials.
